- managing and providing technical support for ESPI's studio room;
- assisting with graphic design activities and other communication activities in ESPI's digital and printed outputs;
- working with ESPI Engagement Staff and Management on continuously improving ESPI's communication and outreach through multimedia channels and platforms;
- contributing to brainstorming sessions for activities and providing creative solutions to reach new audiences and enhance our impact.

This position is a **part of ESPI's Engagement staff**, strengthening ESPI's impact on various audiences and aiming to further develop ESPI's role in advising and promoting European space policy globally, in line with the [ESPI2040](#) vision.

Space is undergoing a transformative change in market dynamics, technology developments, and policy implications. Engagement activities enable ESPI to achieve its mission and strengthen its position and reputation with more impactful outreach towards decision-makers and other target communities. Qualifications

- at least 2 years of relevant work experience (i.e. producing and editing video and audio content in different settings);
- strong understanding and practical use of multimedia outreach channels platforms, and hardware & software tools, in particular audiovisual outputs, with awareness of current best practices;
- intercultural and multistakeholder competence with a self-starting mindset and attention to detail and accuracy;
- flexibility, and impact-oriented thinking;
- a good knowledge and understanding of the space sector, and experience with podcasting, will be considered an asset.
